

CONCURRENT ENROLLMENT

Summer Housing Scholarship



If you are a high school junior or senior planning to take college courses at UTRGV during the summer then you are invited to apply for the Concurrent Enrollment Summer Housing Scholarship! Designed for students who may have difficulty traveling to our campus to attend classes the program offers a limited room & board scholarship. This provides participants the opportunity to reside in a residence hall while earning college credit and experiencing university life first hand!

To qualify for the program, you must:

- First be admitted to the CE Program.
- Attend the April Advisement.
- Submit an essay (200-300 words max) describing "How graduating from UTRGV will help me achieve my career goals."
- Submit two (2) letters of recommendation; one from a Counselor and one from a teacher (form will be provided by the CE Office)
- Priority will be given to students whose home campus is more than 30 miles from the UTRGV campus

Applications will be graded based on the above criteria and those with the highest scores will be selected for the scholarship. Note: The CE Program Office may use additional criteria (i.e. ACT scores, rankings, etc.) to break scoring ties. Please know this is a very competitive scholarship with many applicants and limited scholarships. **Submitting an application does not guarantee an award.**

Scholarship recipients are required to:

- Enroll in at least two UTRGV academic courses (six credit-hour minimum).
- Attend all meetings scheduled by the CE Program Office
- Attend a CESHP Orientation at UTRGV campus (TBA)
- Abide by all rules governing the program and residence hall occupancy.
- Submit all Residence Hall documents prior to move-in date

Admission Requirements for UTRGV Concurrent Enrollment

▪ High School to University Program

UTRGV has made Concurrent Enrollment accessible and affordable for qualified students.

To be admitted into this program, you must meet the following criteria:

- Be in the Top 10% of your graduating class, OR have a 90 GPA or higher, OR have an ACT composite of 22 (or SAT of 1030 using only Critical Reading & Math sections)
- Complete the application process by the deadline(s).
- Attend a mandatory CE Advisement & Registration session

▪ Independent Student Program

Outstanding high school students may apply on an individual basis to participate in Concurrent Enrollment.

To be admitted to Concurrent Enrollment as an independent student, you must meet the following criteria:

- Have an ACT composite of 22 (or SAT of 1030 using only Critical Reading & Math sections), AND one of the following
- Be in the top 10 percent of your graduating class, OR have a 90 or above grade point average
- Submit all application documents by the deadline(s)
