

# New CE Vaquero To-Do List I applied...now what?

Now that you have applied there are a few more items to complete. Make sure you check off each box as you complete each item. All items need to be completed before you can register for classes!

- Make sure your UTRGV ACCOUNT is active** - <https://my.utrgv.edu>

Three to five days after submitting your ApplyTexas you will receive a letter from UTRGV with your Username and Instructions on how to set your Password. Activating your account gives you access to services such as V-Email & BlackBoard. **V-Email is your primary means of communication with UTRGV! You can also track your application status, and sign-up for Advisement once you are accepted into the CE Program!**

- Sign up for NEW CE STUDENT ADVISEMENT** <http://my.utrgv.edu>

Advisement is mandatory for all CE students, so once approved you must sign up for Advisement. During Advisement you will receive CE Program policies, group academic advising, campus tour, Vaquero ID card, and will register for classes. **Remember, the sooner you sign up for Advisement, the sooner you can register!**

- Provide Documentation for MENINGITIS VACCINE**

Beginning Fall 2014, all new students age 21 or younger must submit proof of meningitis vaccination or booster shot (administered within the past five years) before you can enroll. **The vaccine must be current ten (10) days prior to the 1<sup>st</sup> class day of the semester.**

- Check your TSI STATUS** - to find out email us at [ce@utrgv.edu](mailto:ce@utrgv.edu)

The Texas Success Initiative (TSI) requires all entering college students to be assessed for college readiness in reading, writing, and math, unless the student qualifies for an exemption using **one** of the exams below:

- ACT scores: Composite = 23; English = 19 or higher; Math = 19 or higher
- SAT scores: Composite = 1070 (Critical Reading & Math only); CR = 500+; Math = 500+
- STAAR-EOC scores: meet a minimum Level II on English III and Algebra II exams

**If you do not meet one of the exemptions then you must take the TSI Assessment** and meet the required scores (check with CE Office for list of required scores). UTRGV Testing Services offers these exams, and you may contact them at 956-665-7570.

- Send us any COLLEGE CREDIT you've earned**

Send your official transcripts from colleges/universities where credit was earned either by requesting your transcript(s) be sent directly from the college you attended to the UTRGV Admissions Office, or bring it in a sealed envelope. All OFFICIAL college transcripts must include the official seal of the college/university or a signature of a college/university official. Copies of transcript(s) and faxes are considered unofficial. You can also submit your AP Score Report to get college credit (score must be a 3 or higher).
